THIRD PROCEDURAL ORDER

ISSUED: August 2, 2001

By The Commission:

The Commission issued a Procedural Order in this docket on February 9, 2001, and a Second Procedural Order on May 30, 2001. Pursuant to the Second Procedural Order, a Technical Conference was held on July 3, 2001. At that technical conference, in addition to discussing issues related to the cost model and studies the parties filed, the parties discussed the remaining schedule in this matter. The parties in the Technical Conference agreed to the schedule set forth below.

Based upon the foregoing and good cause appearing, the Commission makes the following third procedural order.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

1. The schedule set forth in the Procedural Order issued February 9, 2001, and the Second Procedural Order issued May 30, 2001, shall be amended as follows unless otherwise ordered by the Commission:

- July 16, 2001 AT&T Corporation shall file testimony in support of its proposed cost model. Qwest shall provide testimony explaining any changes it proposes for its proposed cost model.
- August 17, 2001 The Division of Public Utilities and any other party shall file responsive testimony regarding the models proposed by Qwest and AT&T. The Division of Public Utilities shall also file its proposed model.
- September 7, 2001 Surrebuttal testimony due for all parties.
- September 14, 2001 A Technical Conference will be held in room #427, Heber M. Wells building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah, commencing at 10:00 a.m. If a party wishes to participate in the technical conference by telephone, it shall notify the Division at least three business days in advance of the conference.
- September 24-28, 2001 Hearing

2. Hearings in the foregoing schedule shall be held in the Commission's main hearing room #426, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah, and shall commence at 9:00 a.m., unless otherwise directed by the Commission.

3. Discovery and service of any pleadings, motions, testimony, discovery requests, discovery responses, and other filings in this matter shall proceed as set forth in the previous scheduling orders.
