PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On April 12, 2000, U.S. WEST COMMUNICATIONS, INC. (USWC), Petitioner herein, submitted for Commission approval an amendment to the existing interconnection agreement between USWC and DSLnet COMMUNICATIONS, LLC (DSLnet). The matter was submitted for review and recommendation to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU), which filed its memorandum recommending approval of the same June 14, 2000. The proposed amendment will allow DSLnet to access certain pre-existing combinations of unbundled network elements. The proposed amendment does not appear to contravene established law, nor does it appear to be contrary to the public interest. Accordingly, we enter the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The petition is granted and the proposed amendment is approved.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure to do so will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
