The proposed interconnecting party not having been certificated by the Commission, the Commission rejected the agreement.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On November 14, 2000, Qwest Corporation filed for approval an interconnection agreement with SIMPLY CELLULAR & TELEPHONE RECONNECTIONS, LLC, an entity uncertificated by the Commission and which has not applied for certification. Utah law requires interconnecting telephone corporations to be certificated before the Commission may approve such agreements, and perusal of the proposed agreement shows that local exchange service, not just wireless service, is contemplated. Accordingly, we enter the following ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The proposed interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and SIMPLY CELLULAR & TELEPHONE RECONNECTIONS, LLC, be, and it is, disapproved and rejected.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
