PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On December 14, 2000, Petitioner LDM Systems, Inc., filed its pleading seeking decertification and other relief. The Commission's records reflect that Petitioner's application for certification was denied and that Petitioner has never operated as a local exchange carrier in Utah. Since we do not regulate interexchange carriers, Petitioner's activities are outside our jurisdiction. It follows that we must enter the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The matter be, and it is, dismissed.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
