PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On June 1, 2000, Applicant above-named filed its application. The matter was referred to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU), for review and recommendation. Despite repeated requests for information necessary to determine Applicant's eligibility for Certification, Applicant did not furnish the requested information. On January 12, 2001, the DPU filed its memorandum recommending dismissal. Accordingly, we enter the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The above-captioned matter be, and it is, dismissed without prejudice to refiling at such time as Applicant is willing to furnish all necessary information.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure to do so will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
