PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On June 25, 2001, SIGMA NETWORKS TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC. (Petitioner), petitioned the Commission for voluntary cancellation of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, No. 2347, granted December 29, 2000. Petitioner alleges its current business plan does not contemplate the provision of telecommunications services within the State of Utah. Furthermore, as Petitioner does not currently provide telecommunications service to any customers within the state, no detriment to the public interest appears and the Commission hereby issues the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, No. 2347, issued December 29, 2000, to SIGMA NETWORKS TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC., be, and it is, canceled and annulled effective the date of this Order.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
