SYNOPSIS

Grantee having petitioned the Commission to cancel its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, and no detriment to the public interest appearing, the Commission canceled the Certificate.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

BROADBAND OFFICE COMMUNICATIONS, INC. (Grantee) was granted Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2352 under Order dated January 31, 2001. Thereafter, on July 12, 2001, Grantee petitioned to have the Certificate canceled citing financial problems. The matter was referred to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU) for review and recommendation, and DPU filed its memorandum recommending approval on November 1, 2001.

Since the matter has engendered no opposition, and a hearing would be superfluous, and no detriment to the public interest appears, we have determined to dispose of the matter summarily and we enter the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, issued to BROADBAND OFFICE COMMUNICATIONS, INC., be, and it is, canceled and annulled effective the date of this Order.
2. Any person aggrieved by this Order shall petition the Commission within 20 days of the date of this Order for review or rehearing or lose the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
