PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On July 3, 2001, Qwest Corporation filed for approval an interconnection agreement with NOS COMMUNICATIONS, INC., which is not certificated by this Commission, its application having been rejected. Utah law requires interconnecting telephone corporations to be certificated before the Commission may approve such agreements. Accordingly, we enter the following ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The proposed interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and NOS COMMUNICATIONS, INC. be, and it is, disapproved and rejected.
2. Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
