By The Commission:

On December 12, 2001, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) filed a Complaint and Request for Expedited Hearing seeking Commission action associated with its complaints against The Boyer Company LC (Boyer) and FirstDigital Telecom LLC (FirstDigital) relating to the inability of Qwest to connect to end user customers in Gateway in downtown Salt Lake City. On December 19, 2001, Qwest filed Qwest's Motion To Hold Complaint in Abeyance and To Stay Proceedings Pending Implementation of Agreements based on agreements reached between the parties at a meeting called and conducted by the Division of Public Utilities on December 18, 2001. On December 20, 2001, we entered our Order Holding Complaint in Abeyance and Staying Proceeding Pending Implementation of Agreements. The order provided that "[i]n the event the agreements are not implemented in a manner mutually agreeable to the parties, any party may notify the Commission and a scheduling conference will be promptly scheduled by the Commission." On December 28, 2001, Qwest notified the Commission that problems had arisen in implementation of the agreements.

Based upon the foregoing, the Commission hereby gives notice that a hearing will be held on January 3, 2002 at 2:00 p.m. in the Commission's main hearing room, Room 426, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah. The purpose of this hearing is to provide the Commission with a status report on implementation of the agreements reached between the parties on December 18, 2001 and to schedule further proceedings in this matter if necessary. Any party wishing to participate in the hearing by telephone should notify Julie Orchard, Commission Secretary, (801) 530-6713, at least one hour in advance of the hearing.
