The Division has conducted numerous meetings with interested contractors in an attempt to revise the previous PAHD

tariff so that it would be a functional tariff for all parties. During the meetings, Qwest agreed to add provisions which changed the previous PAHD tariff to address many of the contractors issues that were brought forth in the discussions.

However, in spite of the intense discussions, and various proposals presented by all parties, there continues to be issues where agreement could not be reached.

RECOMMENDATION:

Due to renewed intervention of parties and the remaining issues that are at an impasse, the Division recommends that the Commission suspend the revised PAHD Tariff, Docket No. 01-049-T12, and begin a proceeding to resolve the disputed issues.
