ORDER

ISSUED: July 13, 2001

By The Commission:

On July 6, 2001, the Commission suspended proposed revisions to Qwest's tariff contained in advice letters 2001-17 and 2001-21. Since then, Qwest, the Division, and other interested parties arrived at an agreement with respect to the implementation of the changes addressed by advice letter 2001-17. The Division submitted a memorandum to the Commission on July 12, 2001, explaining the implementation agreement and recommending the Commission reinstate the tariff revisions contained in advice letter 2001-17.

We vacate the portions of the July 6, 2001 Order that suspended the tariff revisions contained in advice letter 2001-17. The suspension of the provisions contained in advice letter 2001-21 is not affected by this action. These provisions remain suspended.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the portions of the July 6, 2001 Order, which suspended Qwest's tariff revisions contained in Advice letter 2001-17, are vacated.
