By The Commission:

In these dockets, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) has proposed to offer various N11 services pursuant to a price list filing. In each docket, the Division of Public Utilities has objected to the filing and price list treatment for the proposed services. In Docket No. 01-049-T20, the Commission suspended the proposed price list. Qwest has filed a Petition for Review and Reconsideration in that docket. In Docket No. 01-049-T23, the Division of Public Utilities again objects to the proposed price list treatment for the proposed services.

Because of the opposition to the two filings, involving questions concerning the appropriate regulatory classification for the proposed telecommunications services and the appropriate regulatory consideration of the proposed terms of service, the Commission will hold an evidentiary hearing to resolve the issues raised by these two filings, the Division of Public Utilities' opposition, and the public interest in the provision of the proposed services. The Commission is aware that Qwest has already begun the provision of one of the proposed services, 711 service, in Qwest's Utah service territory. The Commission will require Qwest to continue to provide the service already provisioned, or which may be provisioned, pending completion of these proceedings.

Notice is given that a Hearing on these issues will be held before the Commission on Wednesday, August 22, 2001, at 9:00 a.m., in the Commission's main hearing room no. 426, Heber M. Wells State Office Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.
