SYNOPSIS

No detriment to the public interest appearing, the Commission approved the interconnection agreement.

By the Commission:

On October 10, 2001, Sprint Communications Company, LP (Sprint), Petitioner herein, submitted for Commission approval an interconnection agreement negotiated between Sprint and Qwest Corporation (Qwest). The matter was submitted for review and recommendation to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce which filed its memorandum recommending approval of the same December 18, 2001. The proposed agreement does not appear to contravene established law, nor does it appear to be contrary to the public interest. Accordingly, we enter the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The petition is granted and the proposed interconnection agreement is approved.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
