On May 31, 2001, Level 3 Communications, LLC, petitioned the Commission to enlarge its operating authority to encompass facilities-based, as well as resold services. No detriment to the public interest, and good cause therefor appearing, the Commission enters the following

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The operating authority description in Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2266, issued to Level 3 Communications, LLC, be, and it is, amended by enlarging said authority to include facilities-based, as well as, resold services.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure to do so will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
