Pursuant to notice duly served, the above-captioned matter came on regularly for hearing the sixteenth day of October, 2001, before A. Robert Thurman, Administrative Law Judge, at the Commission Offices, Heber Wells Building, Salt Lake City, Utah. Respondent above-named failed to appear, and based on Respondent's default, and proof that said Respondent has failed to pay its regulatory fee, as required by Utah Statute, which delinquency justifies revocation of the Respondent's operating authority, the Administrative Law Judge enters the following recommended

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2267, issued to CCCUT, INC., dba CONNECT!, be, and it is, canceled and revoked effective the date of this Order.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
