No detriment to the public interest appearing, the Commission approved the proposed name change.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On July 16, 2001, Petitioner, MVX.Com Communications, Inc. filed its Petition seeking a name change to QUANTUMSHIFT COMMUNICATIONS, INC. The matter was referred for review and recommendation to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU), which filed its memorandum recommending approval July 31, 2001. Since there appears to be no detriment to the public interest, and an evidentiary hearing on the matter would appear to be wholly superfluous, we have determined to dispose of the matter summarily. Accordingly we enter the following

ORDER

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The proposed name change is approved and that the records of the Commission be amended to reflect that the name of the holder of the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity issued to MVX.Com Communications, Inc. be, and it is, changed to QUANTUMSHIFT COMMUNICATIONS, INC.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
