PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On April 3, 2001, NETWORK ACCESS SOLUTIONS CORPORATION (NAS) entered into an agreement with SBC TELECOM, INC. (SBC), under the terms of which NAS (with Qwest's Permission) is to assign a physical collocation agreement with Qwest Corporation. The Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU), has reviewed the proposal and found no detriment to the public interest. Our own review discloses no detriment to the public interest. Accordingly, we enter the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The proposed assignment be, and it is, approved.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
