The Division alleges that the Respondent has failed to pay its Public Utilities Regulation Fee that was due on or before July 1, 2001 based on revenues earned during the year ended December 31, 2000.

A Default Order may be taken against Respondent for its failure to respond to this Order to Show Cause.

Further notice is given that the hearing will also consider whether sanctions should be taken against the Respondent for its failure to comply with Utah statutory or administrative rule provisions.
