By The Commission:

On January 2, 2003, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") filed a Petition for Reconsideration or Clarification. Qwest sought reconsideration of our December 12, 2002, Order; or, alternatively, requested that this Commission issue a decision clarifying that the Order is not a final order for purposes of appeal and that Qwest's right to seek reconsideration is preserved until a final order is issued.

Our December order addressed procedural matters raised by Qwest. In it we stated that further proceedings would be conducted and an order issued regarding the application of the LDA tariff. Simultaneous with that order a Notice of Hearing was issued setting an initial scheduling hearing. The December order was a procedural order, and not the final order of this Commission in this matter.

1. Our December 12, 2002 Report and Order is clarified as stated above.
2. Further proceedings will be conducted consistent with that Order.
