By the Commission:

On September 4, 2002, after informal resolution procedures failed, complainant filed a formal complaint involving a disconnection of service stemming from a billing dispute between complainant and Qwest Corporation. On October 3, 2002, the Commission was informed that the parties had resolved the issues raised in the complaint. On October 29, 2002, however, complainant filed an amendment to his complaint expanding the billing dispute to include three additional telephone number accounts. On December 9, 2002, both complainant and respondent's representative contacted the Division of Public Utilities and reported that all issues had been resolved to complainant's satisfaction. Based thereon, the Commission will dismiss the complaint.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

The September 4, 2002, complaint filed herein is dismissed.
