ERRATUM ORDER

ISSUED: April 29, 2002

By The Commission:

On April 24, 2002, the Commission issued a Report and Order approving a one-time distribution from the Universal Service Fund to extend telephone service to the residence of Nathan and Shelly Riggs (the "customer") in San Juan County. In that Report and Order, we approved the cost distribution recommended by the Division of Public Utilities, and granted a waiver of Rule R746-360. In the text of the Report, however, the amounts to be paid by the customer and by Citizen's Communications to extend telephone service to the customer were transposed. The correct amounts to be paid are: \$2,675 from the customer, and \$2,865 from Citizens Communications. The language in the numbered paragraphs of the Order contained the correct figure. The April 24, 2002, Report and Order is hereby amended accordingly.

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63-46b-13, an aggrieved party may file, within 20 days after the date of this Order, a written request for reconsideration by the Commission. Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-7-15, failure to file such a request precludes judicial review of the Order. If the Commission fails to issue an order within 20 days after the filing of such a request, the request shall be deemed denied. Judicial review of this Order may be sought pursuant to the Utah Administrative Procedures Act (Utah Code Ann. §§ 63-46b-1 et seq.)
