SYNOPSIS

No detriment to the public interest appearing, the Commission approved the proposed name change.

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By The Commission:

On February 6, 2002, Petitioner, Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah filed a request seeking Commission approval of a name change to Frontier Communications of Utah. The matter was referred for review and recommendation to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU), which filed its memorandum recommending approval on February 28, 2002. This matter can reasonably be expected to be unopposed and uncontested, and we adjudicate the matter informally under Rule R746-110. Accordingly we enter the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The proposed name change is approved and the records of the Commission be amended to reflect that the name of the holder of the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity issued to Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah is changed to Frontier Communications of Utah.
2. This Order is issued pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R746-110, and shall be effective 20 days after issuance absent meritorious protest.
3. Any person aggrieved by this Order should file a protest prior to the effective date stating the reasons why this Order should not become effective. If the Commission finds merit in such a protest or wishes to further consider such protest, it may delay the effectiveness of this Order.
4. Any person aggrieved by this Order after it becomes effective may file a written request for review or reconsideration in accordance with Utah Code Ann. §§ 54-7-15, 63-46b-12 and 63-46b-13, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure. Failure to do so, may deprive the party of the right to seek judicial review of this Order.
