PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Pursuant to notice duly served, the above-captioned matter came on regularly for hearing the twentieth day of December, 2002, before Douglas Tingey, Administrative Law Judge, at the Commission Offices, Heber Wells Building, Salt Lake City, Utah. Respondent above-named failed to appear, and based on Respondent's default, and proof that said Respondent has failed to file its annual report, as required by Utah Statute, and to pay its Utah regulatory fee, as required by statute, either of which delinquencies would justify revocation of the Respondent's operating authority, the Administrative Law Judge enters the following recommended

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 2325, issued to ONRAMP TELECOM LLC be, and it hereby is, canceled and revoked effective the date of this Order.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure to do so will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
