SYNOPSIS

Zephion Networks Communications, Inc. having requested that its certificate of public convenience and necessity be canceled, the Commission so orders.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On January 31, 2001, Domino Networks Communications, Inc. filed an application for authority to provide ". . . switched and dedicated facilities-based and resold local exchange, facilities-based interexchange, and private line services in the State of Utah." The application was given Docket No. 01-2358-01. Domino Networks notified the Commission by letter dated February 13, 2001, that it had changed its name to Zephion Networks Communications, Inc.

The case was converted into an informal proceeding and there was no hearing held. The Commission granted Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 2358 on April 26, 2001. The order states that Zephion was authorized ". . . to provide local and interexchange services and other public telecommunications services, including facilities-based as well as resold services, within the service territory of Qwest Corporation within the State of Utah."

The Commission has received a memorandum from the Utah Division of Public Utilities stating that the Division has spoken with and received a letter (attached to the memorandum) from the attorneys representing Zephion and has learned that the company has sold its assets and is no longer in existence. The company never provided services in Utah and did not have any customers in Utah. The Division has recommended that the Commission cancel the certificate of public convenience and necessity held by Zephion Networks Communications, Inc.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 2358 held by Zephion Networks Communications, Inc., be and hereby is canceled.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure to do so will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
