On November 15, 2004, Qwest Corporation submitted a tariff filing regarding the matter of grandfathering Local Area Data Services (LADS). The Division of Public Utilities was asked to investigate and report its recommendations by December 8, 2004. Comments on the proposed tariff have been filed by the Division of Public Utilities. The Division recommends suspending the tariff. Based upon the pleadings filed herein, the Commission will suspend the tariff for 45 days, while investigating the impact of eliminating this service on CLEC's who are using this service. The Division will notify the Commission of its finding when the investigation is complete.

The proposed Qwest Corporation tariff filing is suspended for 45 days.
