PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On October 25, 2004, Petitioner, Southwestern Bell Communications Services, Inc. filed its Petition seeking a name change to SBC Long Distance, Inc.. The matter was referred for review and recommendation to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU), which filed its memorandum recommending approval December 21, 2004. Since there appears to be no detriment to the public interest, and an evidentiary hearing on the matter would appear to be wholly superfluous, we have determined to dispose of the matter summarily. Accordingly we enter the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

! The proposed name change is approved and that the records of the Commission be amended to reflect the holder of Certificate of Convenience and Necessity issued to Southern Bell Communication Services, Inc. d/b/a/ SBC Long Distance, be, and it is, changed to SBC Long Distance, Inc.

! Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure to do so will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
