ORDER GRANTING MOTION
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
ANSWER OR OTHER
RESPONSIVE PLEADING

ISSUED: April 1, 2005

By the Commission:

On March 31, 2005, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") filed its Motion for Extension of Time to File Answer or Other Responsive Pleading requesting that the current April 4, 2005, filing deadline be extended for a period of fifteen days after the Commission notifies Qwest that it is necessary for Qwest to respond to the subject Complaint. In support of its Motion, Qwest asserts that it has discussed the nature of the Complaint with Bonnie Reynolds ("Complainant") on several occasions and has been asked by Complainant not to respond to her Complaint until she has contacted an attorney and decided whether to settle her dispute with Qwest. Qwest also indicates that Complainant informed Qwest that Complainant had informed the Commission that the parties are attempting to negotiate a resolution of their differences.

Wherefore, based upon the foregoing information, and for good cause appearing, the Administrative Law Judge enters this ORDER granting Qwest's Motion. Further proceedings in this docket will be scheduled by the Commission as necessary.
