By the Commission:

On August 11, 2005, the Commission issued an Order to Show Cause requiring NetTronix, Inc. ("NetTronix") and its officers to show cause, if any, why NetTronix has not filed an annual report for the year ended December 31, 2004. To date, NetTronix has failed to contact the Commission or to provide any information regarding its failure to file the annual report.

Therefore, **notice** is hereby given that a **hearing** will be conducted by the Administrative Law Judge of the Commission on **Thursday, March 9, 2006, at 9:00 a.m.**, in the Fourth Floor Hearing Room #451, Heber M. Wells State Office Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah, at which time NetTronix and its officers or representatives shall appear to show cause, if any, why NetTronix has failed to file its annual report for 2004, and further to show cause why NetTronix should not be fined and have its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity cancelled for its failure to file the annual report, and have other remedies imposed on NetTronix and its officers.

Individuals wishing to participate by telephone should contact the Commission at least three days prior to the Hearing to make arrangements. On the day of the Hearing,
