SYNOPSIS

SBC is granted approval to discontinue LEC service to its Utah residential customers, effective June 27, 2007.

By The Commission:

On April 26, 2007, SBC Long Distance LLC (SBC) filed an Application to discontinue local exchange service to its Utah residential customers. The proposal is in furtherance of SBC's plans to exit the Utah market; the application and process are made pursuant to Utah Administrative Code Rule R746-350. By Memorandum, dated May 30, 2007, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) provides a summary of its review of SBC's proposal and recommends the Commission approve the Application. No other responses have been submitted to SBC's Application.

Upon review of SBC's Application and the DPU's Memorandum, we conclude that we will grant SBC's Application. We find that SBC has complied with the requirements of Rule 350 and has provided appropriate notice to its customers, other telecommunications carriers and the North American Numbering Plan Administrator to allow service to cease on the proposed date of June 27, 2007.

Wherefore, we enter the ORDER whereby we:

1. Grant SBC Long Distance LLC's Application

2. SBC Long Distance LLC may discontinue local exchange service to its Utah residential customers effective June 27, 2007.

Pursuant to *Utah Code Annotated* §§ 63-46b-12 and 54-7-15, agency review or rehearing of this order may be obtained by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of *Utah Code Annotated* §§ 63-46b-14, 63-46b-16 and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
