ERRATUM ORDER

ISSUED: July 27, 1998

By the Commission:

The Commission issued a Scheduling Order in this Docket on July 6, 1998. On July 15, 1998, AT&T filed a Petition for Review of Procedural Order seeking modification of the Scheduling Order. As a result of reviewing the AT&T motion, the Commission has become aware of an error in the Scheduling Order. The error is the inclusion of the word "lawful" in the Page 2 provisions of the Procedural Schedule dealing with Day 7. The Commission removed "lawful" from the proposed draft order but it was not removed from the final order that issued. The affected portion of the Procedural Schedule should read:

Day 7 Deadline for all parties, including the DPU, to serve discovery on U S WEST and/or other parties. Discovery is limited to thirty (30) data requests, including subparts, unless the requesting party can show good cause why additional data requests should be permitted. A party may also request that U S WEST provide them with responses to the data requests submitted in Montana modified and updated to provide current Utah specific data. Such a request shall not be considered a part of the 30 data requests which a party is otherwise entitled to serve.

The Commission issues this Erratum Order to correct the error in the July 6, 1998, Scheduling Order. With this correction, the Commission deems AT&T's Petition for Review of Procedural Order moot and will not rule upon the Petition.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS that the July 6, 1998, Procedural Schedule provisions for Day 7 are corrected as noted above.
