SECOND AMENDED ORDER

ISSUED: February 18, 1998

By the Commission:

In the Commission's Orders issued January 31 and March 20, 1997, the Commission established the procedure and timetable by which the proposed area code plan would be implemented and established for a permissive dialing period (the time period during which the old area code, 801, may be used for the geographic area given the new area code, 435, and still have a call completed to a telephone subscriber in the new area code territory). The permissive dialing period was scheduled to end on March 22, 1998. The Commission has considered Tel-America of Salt Lake City, Inc.'s Motion to Continue the Permissive Dialing Period. Based on Tel-America's representation that ending the permissive dialing period will render the 700 service ineffective, and recognizing that intralata equal access may be available this summer to solve that problem, the Commission granted the motion. There was no opposition to the motion and good cause appearing therefor, the Commission concluded that the permissive dialing period should be extended from March 22, 1998 until September 20, 1998.

Wherefore, the Commission enters this amended

ORDER

1. The permissive dialing period established in the Order dated March 20, 1997, is modified and will now end on September 20, 1998.
