NOTICE OF RESCHEDULING OF  
TECHNICAL CONFERENCE

ISSUED: March 31, 1998

By the Commission:

On November 19, 1997, the Commission issued a Notice of Hearing in the above-entitled matter to consider the time needed for affected telecommunications corporations to conduct traffic and cost analyses, determine whether EAS bridging problems exist and schedule further proceedings to consider the petition. The Commission set the matter for hearing on December 17, 1997, at which time the Commission established a date of March 9, 1998, for traffic data to be submitted to the Division, March 20, 1998, for the traffic study to be completed and a Technical Conference for March 24, 1998.

Because the EAS rules which were to have governed the flow of information in this case have not been adopted<sup>(1)</sup> the Division may not have the information necessary to do a traffic study by March 20th, therefore, the Commission hereby cancels the Technical Conference scheduled for March 24, 1998, and has rescheduled the Technical Conference to discuss what information may become available and the further steps that should be pursued in considering the service request.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the Technical Conference scheduled for March 24, 1998, in this matter is hereby canceled and rescheduled for 9:00 a.m., Wednesday, April 8, 1998, in Room 427, Heber M. Wells State Office Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.
