By the Commission:

By Report and Order dated May 18, 1998, the Public Service Commission of Utah (the "Commission") granted TELIGENT, INC. ("Teligent") a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") authorizing Teligent, Inc. to provide local and interexchange services and other public telecommunications service anywhere within the State of Utah. The Order failed to note explicitly that the grantee was authorized to serve on a facilities-based as well as resale basis. To correct the oversight, the Commission enters the following

ORDER

WHEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The first paragraph of Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, issued to TELIGENT, INC., be, and it is, amended to read as follows:

The Public Service Commission of Utah, pursuant to the Utah Code Ann. §§ 54-8b-2.1, *et seq.*, hereby issues a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing TELIGENT, INC., to provide local and interexchange services and other public telecommunications services, *facilities-based as well as resale*, anywhere within the State of Utah, as described in Exhibits which shall be filed effective ten (10) days after filing, except within any local exchange with fewer than 5,000 access lines that is owned or controlled by an incumbent telephone company with fewer than 30,000 access lines within the State. The Exhibits shall define the service territory in the State and shall specify the public telecommunications services offered.

Said amendment relates back to the original date of issuance of the Certificate.

In all other respects the terms of our original Order, and Certificate, are confirmed.

This Order is effective the date of its issuance.
