SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER

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ISSUED: August 3, 1998

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 29, 1998, U S West Communications, Inc. (U S West) filed for approval of a proposed IntraLATA Toll Dialing Parity (IntraLATA equal access) implementation plan in accordance with Public Service Commission Rule R746-356. On March 16, 1998, we approved the plan with certain reservations raised by the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce ("DPU"), and AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc. ("AT&T"). Those concerns have since been resolved in the course of a Technical Conference, and U S West customers having a "PIC Freeze" on their long distance account have been notified of the necessity for personally notifying U S West if they wish to change their intra-LATA toll service provider. Additionally, the parties have agreed on the sum of \$.000727 per originating toll or originating switched access minute, or fraction thereof, as a reasonable reimbursement to U S West for equal access costs entailed in customer notification and programming. Accordingly, the Commission enters the following

ORDER

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The customer notice language stipulated by the parties in the DPU Memorandum of May 13, 1998, be and it is approved.
2. U S West's first year Equal Access Recovery Charge, to be billed to each customer's designated Intra-LATA toll carrier, is approved at a rate of \$.000727 per originating toll or originating switched access minute, or fraction thereof.
