PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On April 13, 1999, U.S. WEST COMMUNICATIONS, INC. (USWC) filed its motion for "rehearing, reconsideration, and clarification" in the above-captioned matter. NEXTLINK, UTAH, INC. (Nextlink) filed a memorandum in opposition April 23, 1999. We have reviewed USWC's motion and find the arguments advanced therein are either rehashes of arguments the Commission has considered and rejected or attempts to inject new issues into this proceeding which USWC could and should have advanced earlier. We find the only request having merit is the setting of a deadline for final completion of a contract between the parties. Accordingly, we enter the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the motion of

U.S. WEST COMMUNICATIONS, INC., for rehearing, reconsideration, and clarification, be, and it is, denied with the sole exception that the parties be, and they are, required to file with the Commission a contract for approval no later than June 15, 1999.
