PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On June 24, 1998, Applicant filed its application. The Commission referred the matter to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU), for review and recommendation. On February 4, 1999, DPU filed its memorandum with the Commission noting that Applicant had failed to respond to data requests and recommending disapproval. Accordingly, we enter the following ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

The Application of MOMENTUM TELECOM, INC., be, and it is, denied without prejudice to re-filing at such time as said Applicant is willing to furnish the data requested by DPU.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
