REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER

ISSUED: April 27, 2000

By the Commission:

On April 24, 2000, U.S. WEST COMMUNICATIONS, INC. ("US WEST"), submitted a Stipulated Motion To Enter Revised Scheduling Order in this docket. Based upon the parties' agreement and good cause appearing, the Commission enters the following order setting forth the schedule and procedures for further proceedings in this matter.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The schedule for further proceedings in this matter is as follows:

May 5, 2000

Competitive Local Exchange Carriers ("CLECs") that have not previously filed information with the Division of Public Utilities ("Division"), necessary for the Division to determine which of the services, for which US WEST is seeking pricing flexibility, that the CLECs are providing in the area served by each US WEST central office, shall provide such information to the Division. The information shall include the number of DS-0 equivalent access lines served by the CLEC in each central office and shall, at a minimum, differentiate the lines by switched or non-switched if information by type of service cannot be reasonably compiled within that time.

May 12, 2000

The information shall be provided subject to the Protective Order in this docket and shall not be provided to other parties.

The Division shall provide each party with a cumulative report of all data from CLECs, including information obtained from non-party CLECs, showing, by US WEST central office, what services CLECs are providing. This report shall be subject to the Protective Order in this docket.

May 18, 2000

Conference of all parties commencing at 1:00 p.m. in Room 427, Heber M. Wells Building, to attempt to stipulate to facts regarding same or substitutable services and defined geographic areas for which pricing flexibility is sought. In addition, parties will report on the status of settlement discussions regarding issues of US WEST's compliance with rules and orders of the Commission under Utah Code

Ann. § 54-8b-2.2.

June 9, 2000

All parties to file direct testimony.

June 29, 2000

All parties to file rebuttal testimony.

July 10-11, 2000

Hearings commencing at 9:00 a.m., each day, unless otherwise directed by the Commission.

Prior to the filing of testimony on June 9, 2000, parties shall respond to discovery requests within 14 calendar days of service of the requests, provided that (i) discovery, other than discovery by the Division, shall be suspended until May 18, 2000, and (ii) discovery requests between the parties that were outstanding prior to the suspension of discovery, shall be responded to by May 26, 2000. After the filing of testimony on

June 9, 2000, parties shall respond to discovery requests with 10 calendar days of service of the requests.

- If it is necessary for any party to review the data underlying the cumulative report provided by the Division, regarding same or substitutable services and defined geographic areas, the underlying data shall be treated as highly sensitive information under the terms of the Protective Order in this docket. It shall be made available for inspection only by the party's attorney and one expert of the party not involved in marketing of the party's telecommunications services.
- All hearings scheduled in this matter shall be held in the Commission's main hearing room #426, Heber M. Wells Office Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah 84111.
