SYNOPSIS

No detriment to the public interest appearing, the Commission approved the amendment.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On July 19, 1999, Petitioner US West Communications, Inc., (USWC) submitted the proposed amendment to the interconnection agreement. The matter was referred to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce, (DPU) for review, and DPU filed a memorandum recommending approval August 17, 1999. The Administrative Law Judge, having been fully advised in the matter, now enters the following Report, containing proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and the Order based thereon.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The underlying Interconnection Agreement was approved on November 25, 1997. The proposed amendment addresses reciprocal traffic exchange and a standard billing arrangement.

DISCUSSION

The proposed amendment does not appear to contravene applicable law or present a detriment to the public interest.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The petition should be approved.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

Amendment No. 1 to the interconnection agreement between the above-named parties be, and it is approved.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
