By The Commission:

On May 26, 2000, the Commission issued a Report and Order which approved a proposed tariff of U.S. West Communications, Inc. ("USWC"), to implement the Provisioning Agreement for Housing Developments ("PAHD") tariff provisions as a replacement to the Land Development Agreement ("LDA") tariff. On June 15, 2000, Silver Creek Communications ("SCC"), a participant in the original hearing, filed a Petition for Rehearing, Reconsideration, or Review. As of the date of this Order, no response to SCC's Petition has been filed by any other party.

After consideration of SCC's Petition, the Commission has concluded that it will grant reconsideration of its May 26, 2000, Report and Order. The Commission has determined that the Petition raises issues which warrant reconsideration by the Commission before the Provisioning Agreement for Housing Developments tariff provisions are to be implemented.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The Commission grants reconsideration of its May 26, 2000, Report and Order and suspends that Report and Order until further order of the Commission.
- The Commission suspends the implementation and effectiveness of the Provisioning Agreement for Housing Development (PAHD) tariff provisions until further order of the Commission.
