The approval of the interconnection agreement was granted between US WEST COMMUNICATIONS, INC. and AIRTOUCH COMMUNICATIONS, INC. The Order *should* grant the approval of interconnection between CITIZENS TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANY of UTAH and AIRTOUCH COMMUNICATIONS, INC.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

the name of US WEST COMMUNICATIONS, INC., which now appears in the first paragraph of the Order section be replaced by the name, CITIZENS TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANY of UTAH. This Erratum Order shall be retroactive to the date of issuance of the said Order, September 3, 1999.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
