No detriment to the public interest appearing, the Commission cancelled Certificate No. 2231.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On July 19, 2001, the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU), filed a memorandum in this matter accompanied by a letter from counsel for NOW Communications, Inc. (NCI) The letter represented that NCI had acquired all assets of Tel-Link, LLC, (TL), including its operating authority. NCI holds its own Certificate from this Commission. NCI represents that TL has an extremely limited Utah clientele and that NCI proposes to serve said clientele under its own operating authority, rendering TL's authority redundant. Accordingly, NCI asks us to cancel TL's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity. Since DPU's memorandum recommends approval, and there appears to be no detriment to the public interest, we enter the following ORDER NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2231, issued to Tel-Link, LLC, be, and it is, cancelled and annulled effective the date of this Order.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure to do so will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
