SYNOPSIS

No detriment to the public interest appearing, the Commission approved expansion of the scope of Applicant's local exchange carrier to encompass facilities-based as well as resold services.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On November 22, 1999, Applicant above-named submitted its application to broaden its existing authority to include facilities-based as well as resold local exchange carrier services. The matter was referred to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU) for review and recommendation. On January 5, 2000, DPU filed its memorandum recommending approval. No objection to the broadening of authority having emerged in the interim, and none appearing likely, and further an evidentiary hearing appearing to be neither necessary nor helpful for the disposition of this matter, and further no detriment to the public interest appearing, we have determined to dispose of this matter without further proceedings. Accordingly, we enter the following ORDER

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2263, issued to ADVANCED TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC., be, and it is, amended to include facilities-based as well as resold local exchange carrier services.

- In all other respects, the authority granted, and all conditions imposed on the exercise thereof, shall continue in force.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
