PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On July 18, 2001, Petitioner Firstworld Communications, Inc., authority grantee under our Order dated December 10, 1999, in this matter, filed its Petition seeking voluntary cancellation of its authority and alleging it had not initiated operations in Utah and had no Utah customers who would be affected by such cancellation. Having reviewed the matter, and perceiving no detriment to the public interest, we enter the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2281, issued to Firstworld Communications, Inc., be, and it is, canceled and annulled effective the date of this Order.
2. Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
