PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On December 19, 2000, TRIAD COMMUNICATIONS OF UTAH, INC. (Petitioner), petitioned the Commission for voluntary cancellation of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, No. 2284, issued January 24, 2000. Petitioner alleged it has not commenced operations, deployed equipment, nor hired employees, and has abandoned plans to provide local exchange service in Utah. Since an evidentiary hearing on the matter appears wholly superfluous, and no detriment to the public interest appears, we have determined to grant the petition and issue the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, No. 2284, issued January 24, 2000, to TRIAD COMMUNICATIONS OF UTAH, INC., be, and it is, canceled and annulled effective the date of this Order.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
