PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On May 14, 2001, @LINK NETWORKS, INC. (Petitioner), petitioned the Commission for voluntary cancellation of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, No. 2290, granted December 3, 1999. Petitioner disclosed it has been experiencing financial difficulties and additionally alleged it has been unable to raise additional financing or align itself with a strategic partner. As such, it has ceased doing business and its assets have been or will be liquidated in the near-term. Since an evidentiary hearing on the matter appears wholly superfluous, we have determined to grant the petition and issue the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, No. 2290, issued

December 3, 1999, to @LINK NETWORKS, INC., be, and it is, canceled and annulled effective the date of this Order.

- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
