SCHEDULING ORDER

By the Commission:

In this Commission's previous Report and Order, filing and hearing dates were set for additional proceedings in this matter. The Division of Public Utilities has requested that the schedule be modified, and represented that counsel for Boulder King Ranch Estates Water Company agrees to modification of the schedule as set forth herein. Accordingly, further proceedings in this matter will be as follows:

1. On or before December 20, 2002, the Division of Public Utilities shall file testimony and exhibits updating its previous testimony in this matter, proposing rates and conditions of service for the Company, and addressing other issues in this case.
2. On or before February 7, 2002, Boulder King will file its testimony and exhibits regarding the rates and conditions of service of the Company, and addressing other issues in this case.
3. If the Division wishes to file responsive testimony, it will do so by February 14, 2002.

4. Hearings will be conducted by the Administrative Law Judge of the Public Service Commission of Utah on Tuesday, February 18, 2003, beginning at 9:00 a.m., in the Fourth Floor Hearing Room #451, Heber M. Wells State Office building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah. All parties have the right to be represented by legal counsel. Failure to bring legal counsel will constitute a waiver of the right to representation.
