Testimony of Mark A. Long

I. INTRODUCTION AND SUMMARY

Q. Please state your name, business address and title.

A. My name is Mark A. Long; my business address is 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114; I am a Utility Analyst in the Utah Division of Public Utilities (Division, or DPU).

Q. On whose behalf are you testifying?

A. The Division.

Q. What is the purpose of your testimony in this matter?

A. My testimony discusses issues relating to three Mountain Sewer dockets: the complaint docket, the transfer of ownership docket and the general rate increase and special assessment docket. Specifically, I am recommending that the Commission approve monthly sewer rates of \$25.25 for standby customers and \$84.25 for those customers connected to the sewer system. I am recommending that a one-time Special Assessment of \$204.69 be approved to be paid for equally by all standby and connected customers within 30 days from the date of Commission approval. I am also recommending that the monthly difference between the Interim Rates from May 14, 2012 to the final approval date of the monthly sewer rates, of \$.85 for standby customers and \$27.19 for connected customers be paid in the third month after Commission approval of the final rates. I believe that issues associated with the formal

complaint are resolved and recommend that the complaint be dismissed.
