To Whom It May Concern;

I now represent the interest of Mr. Ed Yoder, President of E & M Water, and his wife Minnie with regards to this entity and the associated well, water storage tank, and water distribution lines. In a memo from the Division of Public Utilities issued March 31, 2011, the Commission was notified that E & M Water was assuming ownership of this water system.

This letter should serve as notice that E & M Water has transferred ownership to the Edmond and Minnie Yoder Living Trust and the water system will now become the property of the Edmond and Minnie Yoder Living Trust, with Edmond Yoder and Minnie Yoder serving as Trustees. It will now be subject to the terms of the Trust for as long as the Trust survives.

Therefore, the Commission should update its records to reflect the new name of The Edmond and Minnie Yoder Living Trust and ownership by The Edmond and Minnie Yoder Living Trust for Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 2369.
