There is currently an effort to submit information regarding water rates and other costs associated with Hi-Country Estates Phase 1 water service to the Public Service Commission. I would like to intervene in this process.

We have lived in Hi-Country Estates Phase 1 for the past thirty one years. We have seen many changes to the water system as it exists today.

The current proposed tariff is unfair to most of the water users and standby users. Tripling the standby fee and receiving no water is not in the best interest of those who own water rights and wells in the Hi-Country Estates Phase 1 Homeowners Association. It is also unfair to those who own multiple lots within the Home Owners Association that require no service at all. Plus the addition of a payment to a monthly reserve fund seems to be excessive. For those water users who use more than the minimum amount of water, the rate should not be lowered. This rate should be raised to conserve water.

Therefore, I am submitting this request to be a party to the process.
