**SUBJECT:** In the Matter of the Application of Hi-Country Estates Homeowners Association for Approval of its Proposed Water Rate Schedules and Water Service Regulations

**RE:** Docket No. 13-2195-02

**ISSUE:**

On September 9, 2013, Hi-Country Estates Homeowners Association (Hi-Country) pursuant to the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission) order issued August 6, 2013 in the above referenced docket filed an addendum to their application with the Commission to approve Hi-Country's proposed water service schedules and rates. Parties have 14 days to challenge the completeness of the addendum or application. The completeness of a filing is defined by Commission rule R746-700-50 and R746-700-51.

**RECOMMENDATION:** ACCEPT THE APPLICATION AS COMPLETE

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) has reviewed the application and addendum, as filed, and believes it should be accepted as a complete filing as contained in the Commission's rule R746-700-50 and F746-700-51.

**DISCUSSION:**

The Division has reviewed the application and addendum and compared the material filed in the addendum and the application to the rules in R746-700-50 and R746-700-51. Based on the review, the Division concludes that Hi-Country has filed information in each required area. Therefore, the Division is not challenging the completeness of the filing. Although the Division has verified that information for each rule exists as required, the Division makes no judgment regarding the accuracy of the information or whether the Division agrees with the information as filed.

The Division requests that the Commission hold a scheduling conference in this docket.
